AGE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the UIPM Under-19 European Championships, athletes must have been born on or after 1st January 1999.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS PER COUNTRY

All countries are invited to bring a maximum of 4 boys, 4 girls and 2 coaches/officials according with UIPM's competition rules.

COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules and will take place at Caldas da Rainha, 90 Km distance from Lisbon International Airport.

Swimming: 25m indoor swimming pool /8 lanes;

Fencing Hall: 8 pistes;

Laser-Run: Pentashot Hit/Miss Targets, track and field surface (spikes allowed);

ACCOMMODATION

- The teams will be staying at the “*Hotel Internacional Caldas****”. The reservations will be on first come first serve basis.
- LOC offers an optional high standard accommodation at “Sana Silver Coast Hotel****”. The reservations will be on first come first serve basis.
- In order to fulfill your accommodation requirements contact LOC.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation from Lisbon International Airport to the official hotel and back is guaranteed only if the delegations provide in due time their flight information before deadline expires (arrival date, departure date, terminal and number of people). The shuttle from the hotel to the competition venues for members of the delegations will be according to the official program.

Important Remark: Extra shuttle fee: 20 €/person (if not on Arrival – (28th or 29th), and Departure, (4th), days)



FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Each country is invited to bring a maximum number of 4 boys, 4 girls and 2 coaches or officials. All delegation members will pay (minimum 4 nights) as follows:

HOTEL CALDAS INTERNACIONAL***

Single Room: 110 EUR / day

Double / Triple Room: 90 EUR / day

HOTEL SANA****

Single Room: 130 EUR / day

Double: 110 EUR / day

It includes full board accommodation with breakfast, packed lunch on competition days, dinner and local transportation. Countries will be financially liable for any damage caused to rooms and their contents. Delegations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee per person to the LOC. The accreditation fee is set at 50 EUR per person per day with a minimum payment of 4 days (200 EUR). For this, we will provide lunch packets for the competition days and transportation between the official airport and competition accommodation.

30% payment requested by bank transfer – only in € (EUR) – before June 30th (Entry B);

70% payment requested by bank transfer or cash – only in € (EUR) – at accreditation desk upon arrival;

NOTE: Following the final entry deadline, all countries must inform the LOC at least seven days prior to arrival of any withdrawals. This is for competition planning purposes and we will not be able to issue any refunds for accommodation costs.

ENTRY FORMS DEADLINES

Deadlines are as follows:

Entry A: June 10th (we would appreciate confirmation of your intention to participate or not)

Entry B: June 30th

Entry Final: July 25th



ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid UIPM issued License. Entry Forms will not be accepted if any athlete is missing his/her License Number. Please contact immediately UIPM Headquarters if your athlete is missing his/her License.

INSURANCE

Under the rules of the UIPM, all members of the delegations should be insured. In case of accidental injury or illness, the Organizer will not accept any liability.

VISAS AND VACCINES

Countries attending the event must confirm, if needed, visa requirements and vaccination for entry into Portugal. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for Visas, but can provide specific letters of invitation if necessary.

FIREARMS

Firearms licenses are not a legal requirement when bringing laser, air and CO2 pistols into Portugal for competition purposes. Please note that under the Portuguese Law athletes under the age of 17 are NOT permitted to carry pistols in public. A team official or coach must be carrying the pistol(s) on their behalf. Please ensure that your laser equipment has been updated with the latest UIPM Code – 2014.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All athletes must wear their official uniform in the competition. Pentashot Hit/Miss targets will be provided by the LOC therefore the athletes are required to bring their own laser pistols. Please also bring a CD with their national anthem and flag of your country (192 x 128cm). Weather conditions: 30°-35° degrees Celsius in August/September
