"My job as a board member will be to contribute to a fair and athlete-oriented use of funds together with the other members," said the 27-year-old Schöneborn.

Keeping her sporting goals for this upcoming season, Schöneborn intends to compete and make an impact in the 2014 World Cup Series as she plans trips to Mexico, Egypt and Budapest with the

focus on qualifying for the World Cup Final before turning her attention to one of the season's main highlight, the World Championships in the Polish capital Warsaw in September.
