Each country can apply to host up to 5 GLRCTs per year, irrespective of participants' gender and abiding by the guidelines of UIPM. GLRCT is an event open to all ages which aims to bring competition and fun to urban communities as well as providing an entry point for young athletes at the base of Modern Pentathlon pyramid who want to progress in the other UIPM Sports.

The bidding candidates will receive full support from UIPM HQ and all UIPM Committees in preparation for and delivery of the UIPM GLOBAL LASER RUN CITY TOUR, ensuring that all involved stakeholders are fully satisfied.

The above-mentioned organizer is bidding for 2022 Global Laser Run City Tour.

Please note:

- This bid document is addressed to UIPM National Federations, their members /clubs/ associations/entities, Institutions and local authorities wishing to apply to host a GLRCT.
- All UIPM Rules and Guidelines are in forced at the time of the event will be applied.
 UIPM is providing the organizers GLRCT Hosting Manual and Venue Dressing
 Guideline with detailed instructions for the conduction of the event as well as UIPM
 GLRCT Online Software Guidelines for participants registration and results submission.
- Besides to return this bid document with signatures of the organizer, the bidder needs to provide relevant documents including letters of support from the local sports authority and the governing body as well as the plans and the pictures of the bidding location of the event that could enhance your candidature.

Timeline:

- The bidding application will be closed on 30th October 2021.
- All bid documents will be analyzed by the UIPM and the UIPM would select the best bidding cities according to relevant criteria before 26th November 2021.
- The successful bids would be informed by the UIPM from 5th December 2021.
- GLRCT events will be organized from March 1st to 31st December 2021.
- For those successful bids, this bidding document will be conducted as hosting agreement and all the bidders would need to sign the declaration page within 5 working days after receiving the confirmation from the UIPM.
- For non-NF organizers, additionally, will need to transfer a certain amount of the hosting fee within 15 working days after receiving UIPM invoice according to the communication during the bidding process, especially for Category "A" GLRCT.



UIPM GLRCT CATEGORIES FOR 2022

Each organizer can apply for GLRCT Categories "A" or "B" indistinguishably up to 5 events per country. For the country that has more than one organizer and apply for more than 5 GLRCTs, UIPM would select the best 5 qualified bidders and cities based on the submission of the bids also considering the conduction of previous GLRCT.

All events registration/entry fee from the participants will belong to the organizer respectively.

Requirement of Category "A" GLRCT:

- 400 participants minimum per event.
- Premium location in an iconic place of the city.
- Full venue dressing according to the UIPM venue dressing guideline at Category "A".
- Impressive spectator/fan experience with professional DJ and commentator, certain entertaining program.
- Advanced social Media promotion and active interaction with the UIPM media department.
- Up to 25 Euro per person as entry fee (not mandatory).
- For non-NF application, the hosting fee of the event would be requested.
- Events organized by NFs remain free of charge

Requirement of Category "B" GLRCT:

- 250 participants minimum per event
- Facilities in an urban environment (downtown, stadiums, park and plaza, etc.)
- Standardized venue dressing according to the UIPM venue dressing guideline at Category "B".
- DJ and commentator involvement for the event
- Social Media promotions and interaction with the UIPM media department.
- Up to 15 Euro per person as entry fee (not mandatory).
- For non-NF application, the hosting fee would be requested.
- Events organized by NFs remain free of charge



Category "A":

- Equipment: Up to 5 sets of Hit and miss targets and full laser pistols per city.
- Equipment allocation will depend on the support provided to the organizer from 2017 to 2021 GLRCT events and also on the UIPM appreciation. Please see the "Note" below.
- UIPM media crew (TV and/or photographer) at UIPM cost
- Relevant templates and samples for each step of the event
- Promotional package for local use.
- Information package for local hired commentators
- Music package for the event
- After the GLRCT hosted according to the bid, UIPM will ship a fencing equipment package to the NF/LOC.

Category "B":

- Equipment: Up to 5 sets of Hit and miss targets and full laser pistols per city.
- Equipment allocation will depend on the support provided to the organizer from 2017 to 2021 GLRCT events and also on the UIPM appreciation. Please see the "Note" below.
- Relevant templates and samples for each step of the event
- Promotional package for local use.
- Information package for local hired commentators
- Music package for the event.

Note:

- UIPM covers the equipment cost and the shipment, while the organizer covers the custom taxes if any.
- For the GLRCTs that are organized by the same organizer in the same country, UIPM could ship allocated equipment in one time to the organizer according to the amount of the event.
- UIPM is entitled to cancel or suspend one or more upcoming GLRCT events (and
 its equipment support) that has awarded to the organizer if the conductions of the
 previous event organized by the same organizer is not according to the standard
 and guidelines.



GLRCT Experts are UIPM Representatives assigned to different GLRCT events in order to assist and guide the organizers, as well as to ensure the events are conducted according to set standards of respective category. UIPM is organizing the Experts workshop at the beginning of each season to update all the experts for different aspects related to the events.

- For the events that UIPM sends Experts, UIPM will cover the international travel and the per diem, the organizer would provide the local accommodation.
- The period of stay can vary from 2 days up to 4 days, depending on the needs of the preparation/training, complexity of the event and the travel distance of the experts.



• Shooting and running distance of the GLRCT at open division is as below:

- Organizers to recruit the athletes/participants and register them according to the UIPM GLRCT Online Software Guidelines
- All the results of the events should be managed according to the UIPM GLRCT
 Online Software Guidelines and uploaded at the UIPM portal within 48 hours.
- Laser Run World Rankings will be created and permanently updated at UIPM website. Athletes will earn points according to their ranking in each competition they take part.
- More detailed information is provided in the Hosting manual.



The LOC will provide for all participants:

- Unlimited bottled mineral water on venue throughout the competition.
- If possible, some fruits and snacks for participants as supplement.

One ambulance on site is recommended

- On site medical care with resuscitation capability is recommended.
- General medical assistance must be available to all participants and spectators as it is generally to the public
- Sanitary facilities must be provided for athletes and participants on the FOP.

LOCs must send full media report including written articles, local coverage, web links of local media and pictures within 1 week after the event
