

BESKYD TATRA CHALLENDGER 2024 International Championship of the Czech Republic and UIPM Global Laser Run City Tour Kopřivnice 2024

Dear friends,

Sports club LSK Frýdek-Místek, the UIPM (Union Internationale de Pentathlon Moderne) and the Czech Modern Pentathlon Association would like to invite delegations from your clubs to participate in the Beskyd Tatra Challenger 2024, which will include the International Championship of the Czech Republic in Laser Run and UIPM Global Laser Run City Tour. It will be held in the town Kopřivnice, the birthplace of the legendary Emil Zátopek and Tatra trucks on 7 to 8 September 2024 according to the following programme, which will be published on 1 July 2024 <u>www.beskydchallenger.com</u> . We will publish the whole schedule after registrations are complete.

General information

Date of event: 7 - 8 September 2024 Age categories: U11, U13, U15, U17, U19 and Juniors (U23) Races: individual Registration: begins 1 April 2024 and ends 21 August 2024 (registration forms are in the attachment)

Competition rules

The competition will take place in accordance with the UIPM Competition Rules and Regulations and other applicable regulations:

- Shooting: 22 targets at the main shooting range plus two spares (homologated Hit&Miss targets), and 10 to 20 targets on the warm-up shooting range. Athletes may bring their own targets and use them for warm-up purposes if they wish.
- Running: tartan

Notes:

1) Qualification rounds will take place depending on the number of registered participants in each age category. If qualifying rounds are required for an age group, they will be held in the morning and, if necessary, semi-finals will be held in the afternoon. The finals will be held on Sunday, 8 September 2024.

2) Categories and distances will be governed by UIPM rules:

3) Delegations can register an unlimited number of athletes.

4) Access to races will be strictly regulated by the accreditation system, including the access of coaches to the warm-up zone. Delegations may register 1 coach for every 4



athletes (e.g. a delegation with 4 athletes = 1 accredited coach; a delegation with 6 athletes = 2 accredited coaches).

Entry fee

Each registered competitor pays a uniform entry fee of CZK 500 / EUR 20. A fee of CZK 100 / EUR 5 will be added to the entry fee for registrations after the registration deadline.

The entry fee includes a lunch package.

Attention! You cannot request a refund for cancellation of your registration after 1 September 2023.

Equipment for laser shooting

A firearms licence is not required by law to import air and CO2 powered pistols into the Czech Republic for competition purposes. However, if you are travelling by air, we strongly recommend that delegations carry an official letter stating the purpose of their visit and the serial numbers of the pistols.
