RULES

The Competition will be carried out according to the UIPM rules.

- **Fencing:** 5 pistes.
 - **Obstacles:** 8 Obstacles on a course 60-80m length
 - **Swimming:** 25m indoor pool/5 lanes, manual time system
 - **Shooting:** 36 +2 laser targets EcoAims hit & miss provided

ATHLETES LICENSES

To participate in official UIPM events, athletes are required to have a license number registered on the UIPM web portal. Holding a license is a prerequisite for registration. Athletes without a license will not be permitted to participate, in accordance with the rules.

Registration forms will not be accepted if an athlete lacks a license number. If an athlete does not have a license, the UIPM headquarters must be contacted immediately.

EQUIPMENT

Fencing equipment control will take place immediately before the first round, and the laser pistol check will be conducted prior to the competition warm-up.

COMPETITION VENUE

The competition will take place at the Austrian School of Guatemala: Boulevard Austriaco 23-90, Zone 16, Guatemala City 01016.

WARNING

Should a minor athlete be in need to share the hotel accommodation with another adult athlete (18+) or with an accompanying adult (e.g., Coach) it is required for such arrangement to be supported by the prior written consent of the parents/legal guardian of each of the minors. Providing the requested written consent is a must for checking in the competition hotel.

ENTRIES

There is no limit on the number of registered athletes per country for the U13 and U15 categories. For the U17, U19, and Junior categories, the number of permitted entrants is 4 athletes per gender per country. Additional athletes from the host country will be permitted if the total count of 36 athletes per gender is not reached; the LOC will prioritize entries based on the order of registration. The U13, U15, U17, U19, and Junior competitions will be held in a direct final format. The fencing competitions will follow a Ranking Round (RR) format.



Results for each stage, for both girls and boys, will be derived as follows:

- 1- Pan American Open Pentathlon (Individual, Team)
- 2- NORCECA Open Pentathlon (Individual, Team)
- 3- Pan American Open Pentathlon (Mixed Relay)
- 4- NORCECA Open Pentathlon (Mixed Relay)

Results for the Obstacle and Obstacle-Laser Run competitions will be derived using the same results as the pentathlon competitions, as follows:

- 5- Pan American Open Obstacle (Individual)
- 6- NORCECA Open Obstacle (Individual)
- 7- Pan American Open Obstacle-Laser Run (Individual)
- 8- NORCECA Open Obstacle-Laser Run (Individual)

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All delegations and countries must book their own accommodation independently of the organizing committee. Each country must pay an accreditation fee of 75 USD per day of competition, with a minimum of four days per athlete, coach, guest, or delegate. This fee must be paid prior to the championship's first technical meeting as a prerequisite for registration, which opens on December 1. Each registration includes the following:

- Boxed lunch
- Access to the competitions.

PAYMENT METHOD:

- **Prior to arrival:** Transfer via a Neonet link provided upon confirmation (this link is valid for 48 hours).
- **At the first technical meeting location:** Cash or international card.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Federations are advised of the following submission deadlines:

- Form A: by September 13, 2026
- Form B: by October 11, 2026
- Form C: by November 8, 2026

If Form C (final registration) is not received by the deadline, the delegation will be considered not to be participating in the competition.

If, upon arrival at the competition, a delegation fails to present athletes or officials included in the final registration—and has not notified the LOC 10 days prior to arrival—the National Federation must pay USD 250 for each absent person.

Following the confirmation of final registrations, each federation must participate with at least one pentathlete.



If a federation fails to participate after having submitted its final registration, it will be sanctioned with a fine of USD 600, payable directly to the UIPM.

VISAS AND VACCINATION

Some countries require a visa to enter Guatemala. This process must be completed well in advance.

The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will provide official invitation letters to delegations that require them to facilitate the visa application process.

INSURANCE

All members of the delegation must have medical insurance. The organizers will not assume any financial or other liability for accidents or other incidents.

LASER PISTOLS

The LOC strongly recommends that all delegations carry an official letter from their respective national federations or associations declaring the personal equipment to be used for the competition, including the athletes' names and passport numbers, as well as details of each pistol.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Athletes are encouraged to wear their country's official uniform during competitions and ceremonies. For relay events, competitors must wear the same uniform.

Guatemala City is located approximately 1,500 meters above sea level. During December, the average temperature ranges from 13°C to 23°C, with cool, dry weather featuring sunny days and cold nights.

Please also bring a recording of your national anthem and your country's flag (120 x 80 cm).
