Following these inspiring words, allow me to add a perspective rooted in the long-standing tradition and values of modern pentathlon.



PARTICIPATION

Athletes eligible to participate in the FISU World University Championship 2026 must meet the following conditions:

- Be at least 18 years old and under 25 years of age on 31 December of the year of the event; for 2026, athletes must have been born between 01/01/2001 and 31/12/2008; **and**
- Be students who are officially registered and studying for a degree or diploma at a university or similar institution. (Athletes must represent the same country in FISU events as they do in competitions held by their respective International Federations. Any change of sport nationality must follow the rules of the relevant International Federation), Athletes must be citizens of the country they represent, the status of which is recognised by the relevant national academic authority in their country; **or**
- Be former students of the above-mentioned institutions who obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

In the individual competition there will be a maximum of 6 participants per national team and gender.

In the team competition there will be 2 participants per gender.

- Quantitative Entry + 50% deposit – 25 May 2026
- Individual Entry + Travel Plans – 24 July 2026
- Remaining payment – 14 August 2026

All general, quantitative and individual entries, as well as travel plans for each participant, must be completed online through the FISU GMS.

The access to the GMS is only given to the NUSF, who are responsible for all registrations.

MEDICAL

All official participants have access to medical services, including an on-duty doctor, hospital and clinic support.

A medical centre with ambulance and first aid services will be available at the Competition Venue.

Basic first aid, ambulance and physiotherapy services are covered.

Any additional medical costs must be covered by the athletes' own medical insurance.

The Host Organising Committee does not cover hospital, dental or other medical treatment expenses.

ENTRY FEES

FISU Fees:

- €20 per athlete/official (members).
- €40 (non-members).

These fees Will be charged to participating delegations by FISU.

LOC Participation Fees:

- €80 per person/night (FISU standard).
- €160 for additional officials.

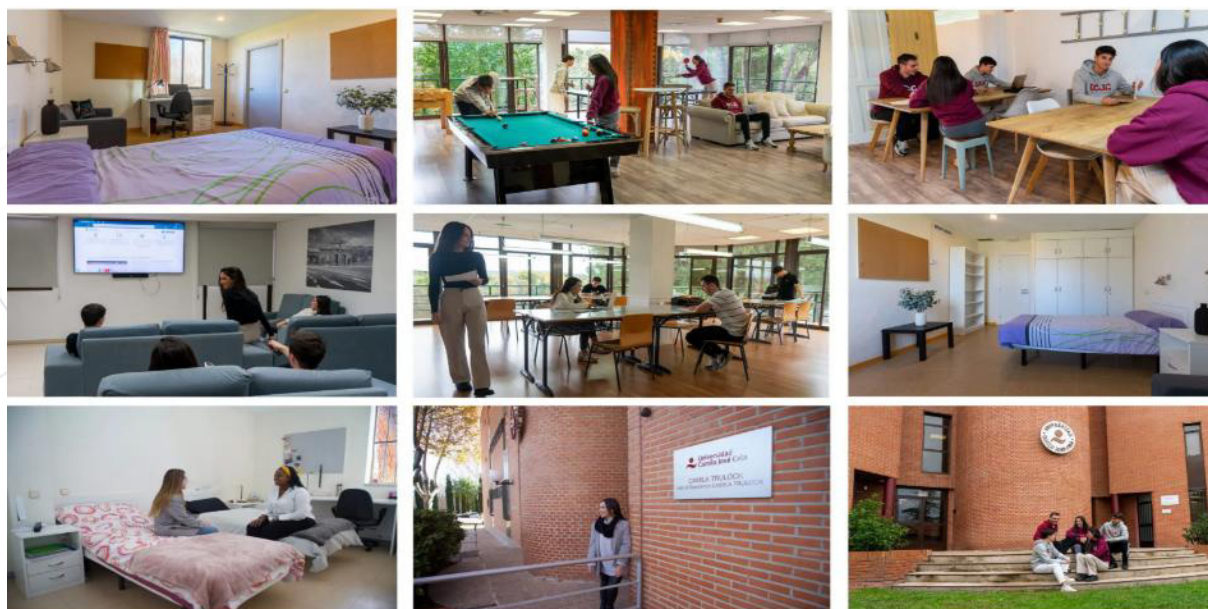


It is recommended that **special sports equipment** be checked in and **properly labelled** in order to avoid any potential issues during travel.

ACCOMMODATION

The official accommodation will be in residences located in the **UCJC Villafranca Campus**, all in the same area; with full board and direct access to the sports venue. People will be accommodated in one residence or another according to the order of registration. More details in forthcoming newsletters.

Further details regarding **meal service hours** will be communicated to the delegations prior to arrival.

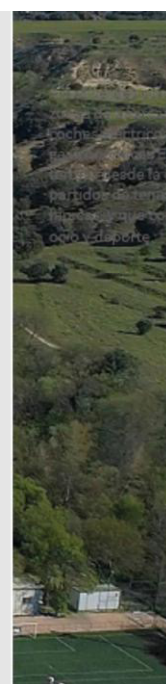
TRANSPORT AND OFFICIAL ENTRY POINT

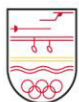
