COMPETITION FORMAT/RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules and Regulations.

Swimming:	25m Indoor pool / 8 lanes
Fencing:	9 pistes indoor & 1 Bonus Round piste indoor
Laser Run:	36+2 shooting range with Ecoaims LT600 PRO targets
Running Course:	600m lap, Cross Country loop, grass/gravel /concrete/tartan
Obstacle:	U shape indoor, parquet, Consist of following obstacles: Steps, Big Wheel, 1.5m Wall, Rings, Balance Beam, Wheels, Monkey Bars, Finish Wall.

COMPETITION VENUES

Swimming, Fencing, Laser Run and Obstacle will be held in LSC sport complex „Druskininkai“ M. K. Čiurlionio g. 115A, 66161 Druskininkai

ACCOMMODATION

For delegations/participants choosing to stay in the official competition hotel, participants will be accommodated in 3- or 4-stars hotels located in the center of Druskininkai city. The Technical Meeting and LOC Office will be located at the Lithuanian Olympic Center hotel.

Please note that if you are interested in staying at one of the 4-stars hotels, we recommend that you register for the event as soon as possible to increase your chances of securing a room in your preferred hotel.

WARNING

Should a minor athlete be in need to share the hotel accommodation with another adult athlete (18+) or with an accompanying adult (e.g., Coach) it is required for such arrangement to be supported by the prior written consent of the parents/legal guardian of each of the minors. Providing the requested written consent is a must for checking in the competition hotel(s).

TRANSPORT

LOC guarantees transportation from the national airports of Vilnius and Kaunas and Bus station of Druskininkai to all the official hotels and the return journey on the arrival and departure days. Maximum waiting hours in the airport is 1 hour.

Transportation from the Official Hotels to the Technical Meeting and the venues for delegations will be arranged according to the competition program.

SUSTAINABILITY

All CO2 emissions generated by the LOC in organizing this event will be measured after the competition. Based on previous competition data, the Lithuanian Modern Pentathlon Federation plans to plant 1,500 trees to offset the CO2 produced by the LOC for the UIPM 2024 U19 World Championships and achieve the first zero-emission UIPM competition.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

For delegations (athletes, coaches, officials, supporters) reserving the conditions accommodation package, the prices are as follows:

Single rooms are limited.

- This price includes full board accommodation, local transportation.
- **Delegations choosing to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee to the LOC for each participant (athlete, coach, or official). The accreditation fee is set at EUR 50 per person per day, with a minimum payment requirement of 4 days. This fee includes lunch on competition days and access to official transportation between the competition hotel and competition sites.**
- The check-out hour is 11.00 am. If the delegates will stay more time must pay additionally for accommodation and/or meals (½ day). Please inform the LOC about the extension of the extra day and extra meal.
- In the case of a bank transfer, the Head of the delegation must have a confirmation of the transfer with him.

ATTENTION! All extra costs for bank transfers must be paid by the national federations. Otherwise, the amount will be invoiced afterward.

Paying cash upon arrival is only accepted if you have written approval from the LOC to do so and all financial conditions (costs) will be calculated on the prices mentioned above.

As a reminder, if on arrival for the competition, the team has fewer athletes and/or officials than listed on their Final Entry Form and without informing the LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of 200 Euros for each person not attending.

At the same time as submitting the Final Entry Forms all NFs must send to the LOC by electronic bank transfer or other means, 30% of the total amount of their accommodation invoice, otherwise their reservation will not be guaranteed.

DEADLINES

Delegations are kindly reminded that the UIPM Online registration system is obligatory. The online system will be open from 1 July 2024. All information must be submitted, including flight information, pistol serial numbers and accommodation bookings by 20 August 2024. Any changes after this must be sent by email to the organizer mpwch2024@gmail.com

Following the closure of the registration system on 1 September 2024, an NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete/team per confirmed gender or Women, Mixed or Men Relay. Any failure to take part having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600€ to the UIPM.

If we do not receive complete information about your delegation prior to the closure of the registration system or we do not receive your delegation's payment, confirmation then we will consider your delegation as non-participating.

ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition. You are reminded of Rule 1.12.1 i).

INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules, all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury and illness.

The organizer will not accept any financial liability or loss, injury or illness that occurred to any participant and or member of the delegation.

VISAS & VACCINATIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

All athletes are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a track/record of your anthem and a national flag (120 x 80 cm).

Expected Weather conditions: The average maximum daytime temperature in Druskininkai in September lies at 18.2°C (64.76°F). The average minimum temperature goes down to around 8.3°C (46.94°F) (often the minimum temperature is noted at night).

Rainfall during September is moderate with an average of 54mm (2.1 inches). There are generally around 11 rainy days.
