COMPETITION FORMAT/RULES

The competition will be carried out according to UIPM Rules.

- Swimming: 50m Indoor pool / 10 lanes
- Fencing: 9+1 pistes indoor(RR)/ 1 separate piste(BR)
- Laser Run: 36+2 shooting range with precision laser targets (ALS)
- Running Course: Running track and natural lawn

TRANSPORT

Transportation from the Incheon or Gimpo International airport to the official hotel and the return journey is only guaranteed if the arrival information is provided in the registration system in good time and prior to the deadline.

Transportation from the Official hotel to the competition venues for all the athletes will be according to the training and competition programs.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

For delegations(athletes, coaches, officials, supporters) reserving full board;

- Single \$180 per person per night
- Double \$150 per person per night

Each price includes full board accommodation, breakfast(Buffet), lunch(lunch packets at the venue), dinner(Buffet) and shuttle from/to the International Airport.

(ATTENTION)

All extra costs for bank transfer should be covered by the national federation. Otherwise, the amount will be invoiced afterwards.

Paying cash upon arrival is only accepted if you have a written approval from the LOC.

As a reminder, if on arrival at the competition, teams arriving with fewer athletes, coaches and/or officials than submitted in the registration system and without informing the Organizing Nation/LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will have to pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of 200 € for each person not attending.

DEADLINES

Delegations are kindly reminded to complete attached **form A, B and C** and send them back to LOC at mpbuk@unitel.co.kr, according to following deadlines;

However, the early confirmation of your intention to participate or not would be highly appreciated.

- **Form A: no later than 31st July 2021 (Participation Confirmation)**
- **Form B: 20th August 2021 (Names and flight info)**
- **Form C: 17th September 2021 (Final)**

The deadline to transfer the total amount of accommodation is 17th September 21.

After the deadline on **17th September 2021**, a NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete/team per confirmed gender or Women, Men or Mixed Relay. Any failure to take part having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600 € to the LOC.

ATHLETES LICENSES/RIDING ABILITY

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

You are reminded of Rule 1.12.1 ii): Pentathletes must have sufficient riding ability to compete and be in possession of riding certificates. Such letter/certificate must be uploaded on UIPM portal before registration and some video footage might be asked prior to the event.

Note: Riders can be stopped at any time during warm up and competition if displaying non-sufficient riding ability or dangerous riding.

INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury and illness. We highly recommend an insurance covering COVID-19 cases as well.

The organizer will not accept any financial liability or loss, injury or illness occurred to any participant and or member of delegation.

LASER PISTOLS

Firearms licenses are not a legal requirement when bringing laser pistols into Korea for competition purposes.

VISAS & VACCINATIONS

The LOC can provide specific letters of invitation or invitation by name or communicating with your embassies if needed. If you need a visa or vaccinations please contact your nearest Embassy or Consulate.

Notice: All Participating National federations MUST send the passport copies of their delegation to LOC as soon as possible but not later than 23rd August 2021.

COVID-19

The LOC is committed to take all preventive measures against COVID-19 infection during the competition time, following all recommendations from both Korean local government and UIPM.

All passengers travelling to Korea must be in possession of printed negative PCR test certificates(3 copies) for COVID-19 which was tested within 72 hours before flight departure time.

Updated information on the Covid-19 test needs to enter Korea and other arrangements for participating in the competition will be provided later.

Please also bring a track/record of your anthem and a national flag(120x80cm).
