

UIPM manages its development budget through a clear and transparent two-pillar structure.

One part of the development budget is allocated to the Continental Confederations. The distribution of these funds is based on an objective calculation that considers key performance and engagement indicators, notably the rate of development survey responses from member federations and their participation in UIPM Events, as well as regional/continental or other international events. This methodology promotes active engagement, accurate reporting and alignment with UIPM development priorities. Each Confederation submits, at the beginning of the year, a comprehensive and independent budget proposal outlining the initiatives it intends to support, ensuring transparency in the use of allocated funds.

The remaining portion of the development budget is managed directly by UIPM. This centrally administered budget follows a structure approved by the General Assembly on a biennial basis and enables UIPM to address the operational and development needs of National Federations. Support under this framework may include:

- Instructors' travelling and working costs
- Provision of equipment and direct support to National Federations
- Organisation of training camps and educational seminars
- Support for development competitions
- Development of new events and related operational activities

This dual-management model ensures strategic oversight, accountability and flexibility, while delivering targeted and practical development support across all regions in line with UIPM's objectives.
