

UIPM actively monitors the governance compliance of its member associations with the UIPM Statutes, Code of Ethics, and other applicable regulations.

This monitoring process includes regular reviews of statutory documents, reporting requirements, and governance practices to ensure alignment with established rules and international standards.

One of the examples is the development status [survey](#) that was shared with all National Federations in 2025. The survey is aimed at understanding the current development status of all Federations in terms of activities, access to equipment but also to receive all the most recent founding documents and digitalize them to have an easy access as many member federations have been approved before internet existed.

In 2025, around 72% of the member federations have sent back the development status survey.

Where gaps or risks are identified, UIPM engages constructively with the concerned member associations to provide guidance, corrective recommendations, and follow-up support.

This ongoing oversight contributes to safeguarding integrity, reinforcing accountability, and maintaining a consistent governance framework across the UIPM membership, while supporting the sustainable and ethical development of modern pentathlon worldwide.
