

UIPM manages its development budget through clearly defined [policies](#).

Within this framework, UIPM development support is structured around several key areas:

- **Equipment, provision and direct support to National Federations (NFs)**, including financial assistance for the purchase and shipment of sport-specific equipment required for training and competition.
- **Participation in UIPM events**, where support may cover essential travel-related costs such as international or domestic flights, ground transportation, accommodation, accreditation fees, and, where applicable, entry or registration fees.
- **Education and certification programmes (CCP & JCP)**, with eligible expenses including course organisation, instructors' travel and fees, educational materials, venue rental, and participant travel costs.
- **Athlete training and performance development**, which may include support for training camps, coaching services, facility rental, and performance-related services aligned with approved development objectives.
- **Development competitions and new event initiatives**, covering operational costs related to the organisation, testing, and implementation of new formats or development-focused competitions.

This structured approach ensures that UIPM development funding is allocated consistently, transparently, and in direct support of the long-term growth and sustainability of modern pentathlon worldwide.
