ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO ALL CANDIDATES

- shall not be undischarged bankrupt;
- shall not be younger than 18 years;
- shall never have been condemned for an offence punishable by a term of imprisonment of two or more years unless that person has obtained a pardon or served the sentence;
- shall not be banned from being a company director;
- shall not be subject to an order that the individual lacks competence to manage their own affairs;
- shall not have been deprived of civil rights by proper application of the law;
- shall not have been sanctioned for a breach of any IOC rule or the UIPM Code of Ethics or UIPM Anti-Doping Rules or any other UIPM Rules;
- shall never have been removed from UIPM office in accordance with the UIPM rules;
- shall never have been prohibited from holding such position, or any similar position, under any other circumstances as provided by law;
- shall have decent communication skills in English;
- shall not be a member of the Electoral Committee.

SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

ATHLETES COMMITTEE

- Must have never received any sanction in relation to the World Anti-Doping Code nor in any case connected with betting and manipulation of competitions. (UIPM Election Rules, art. 4.1)
- To be eligible an athlete must be internationally ranked in the last two seasons before the elections. (UIPM Rules of Internal Organization, art. 4.7)

COACHES COMMITTEE

- Must have never received any sanction in relation to the World Anti-Doping Code nor in any case connected with betting and manipulation of competitions. (UIPM Election Rules, art. 4.1)
- Candidates to the Coaches' Committee must (i) hold an international license/certificate issued by UIPM; and (ii) be an active coach at international level in any one or more of the UIPM disciplines. (UIPM Election Rules, art. 4.1)

MASTERS COMMITTEE

- Must have never received any sanction in relation to the World Anti-Doping Code nor in any case connected with betting and manipulation of competitions. (UIPM Election Rules, art. 4.1)
- All active Master athletes of Modern Pentathlon are eligible. (UIPM Rules of Internal Organization, art. 4.10)

MEDICAL COMMITTEE

• Must be practising physicians with special knowledge in sports medicine, pharmacology, biochemistry and in laboratory control. (UIPM Election Rules, art. 4.1)

TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

■ Must hold a valid license of the UIPM Judges Certification Programme level 3 (international Judges in all 5 Modern Pentathlon disciplines. (UIPM Election Rules, art 4.1)

HONORARY AUDITORS

- Candidates to be Honorary Auditors shall:
 - (i) have
 - (a) a university degree in accounting, finance, or law, or (b) a recognized license or certification in practice of accounting such as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), Certified Financial Analyst (CFA), Certified Management Accountant (CMA), Enrolled Agent (EA), Certified Internal Auditor (CIA), Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA), Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE), Certified Government Auditing Professional (CGAP), Certified Bank Auditor (CBA), or similar certification or experience, as determined by the Electoral Committee, and (c) a thorough understanding of general accounting and budget principles, and
- (ii) be independent, which shall mean a person who is not a President, Secretary General, Executive Board member or employee of a Member. (UIPM Election Rules, art 4.1)
