



# ASIAN MODERN PENTATHLON CONFEDERATION - AMPC

## Report of Vice President\_2017-2021

Dear members of the modern pentathlon family in Asia. Wish you a health and well-being.

During my tenure as vice president of AMPC, the following has been done; Kyrgyz athletes(I am the president of the federation), took part in 6 World Championships(adults, youths, cadets); 4 stages of the World Cup, as well as in all Asian Championships. Our team of men and women performed with dignity at the 2018 Asian Games in Jakarta, Indonesia.

Under the leadership of AMPC, we successfully organized the Asian Championship in modern pentathlon in the mountains of Lake Issyk-Kul. A huge work was done to hold it worthily. 13 countries, more than 110 athletes took part. Vice Prime Minister of the Kyrgyz Republic, Minister of Sports, Secretary General of the National Olympic Committee helped us a lot for the successful competition. We also highly appreciated of UIPM President Dr Klaus Schorman and AMPC President Mr. Park highly for their supports.

For the first time in 60 years, Kyrgyzstan won 11 medals(1 - gold, 2 - silver, 8 - bronze) and became the second in the total count of countries. In addition to the Asian Championship, during the reporting period, our federation was involved in organizing and conducting other international competitions, so the UIPM-approved international tournament in memory of the three-time world champion Horishko is held annually. 18 countries participated in the last tournament before the pandemic(including the Olympic champions from Australia-Esposito). For holding this competition, AMPC presented us with an award for "the best organization of the competition", we also hold an annual tournament, the Central Asian Cup & Open championships of Kyrgyzstan. (This is a total of 16 competitions). Olympic Youth Games!

I would like to emphasize that in these achievements, there was a huge help from AMPC and Korean Federation(President Mr Park and his office).

As vice-president of the AMPC and the president of the federation of Kyrgyzstan, I constantly participated in events, congresses of the UIPM and AMPC. As Vice President, I also represented the Asian Confederation at the Asian Biathle and Triathle Championships in Kazakhstan.

In recent years, the federation has been actively involved in and promoting such sports as Laser-run, Biathle, Triathle(Tetratlon for youth & student athletes)

I wish you all good luck and further development of modern pentathlon in Asia.
