



UIPM Executive Board Meeting

The UIPM Executive Board (EB) adopted the following Motions from National Federations to be tabled at the 2016 UIPM Congress in Frankfurt-am-Main (GER):

Change scoring in Swimming (BLR): To reduce the value of 1sec from 3pts to 2pts, with a view to stimulating Modern Pentathlon development in countries where Swimming pools are limited.

Extend minimum Riding course length (CAN): To extend minimum length to 400-450m.

Change qualification system for finals (FIN): To add more fairness to competitions by rewarding athletes who finish high within their qualifying groups and also those who score highly.

The EB approved the UIPM calendar for 2017 and 2018:

The EB supported the approval of Haiti as a new National Federation.

The EB reconvened with new Members elected at the 2016 UIPM Congress and agreed on the appointment of Christian Roudaut (FRA) as Chairperson of the Coaches Committee, Peter Engerisser (GER) as Chairperson of the Masters Committee and Ivar Sisniega (MEX) as Chairperson of the Innovation Commission.

Youth Olympic Games 2018 qualification system: The EB (existing members only, not new members) agreed to revert to the IOC qualification format due to a lack of symmetry with the UIPM age eligibility system, and agreed on other regulations aimed at ensuring the fairest possible qualifying procedure across all continents.
