

The UIPM Executive Board (EB) convened in Kaunas, Lithuania alongside the UIPM 2025 Pentathlon World Championships, chaired by President Rob Stull. Opening remarks highlighted strategic priorities for 2026-28, with a focus on commercial growth, global expansion and positioning Modern Pentathlon on a sustainable trajectory toward Los Angeles 2028 and Brisbane 2032.

The EB approved the minutes of its January and April 2025 meetings, discussed improved reporting and governance processes, and received updates on LA28 planning, including venue requirements, qualification systems and technical engagement with the IOC. The EB also reviewed financials confirming budget discipline and discussed confederation support frameworks for 2026 onwards.

A major focus was the awarding of competitions and events for 2026-28, providing a clear calendar for National Federations (NFs) and athletes. The EB approved the following hosts:
