The UIPM Executive Board (EB) convened online across two sessions in April 2025, chaired by President Rob Stull. The meeting opened with a briefing from IOC Sport Director Kit McConnell, following the IOC's decision to reduce the athlete quota for Modern Pentathlon at the Los Angeles 2028 Games from 72 to 64. Mr McConnell addressed the rationale behind the decision, future format considerations, the Olympic programme evaluation process and prospects towards Brisbane 2032, engaging in an open exchange with Board members.

Subsequent discussions focused on UIPM's strategic positioning within the Olympic movement, including presentation of the sport at major events in 2025 and 2026, media impact, primetime scheduling and strengthening relationships with key IOC stakeholders. The Board agreed to create a UIPM Obstacle Taskforce, chaired by the President, to support national-level integration between UIPM federations and equivalent bodies in the governance of Obstacle sports.

The EB unanimously approved the awarding of the following events:

- UIPM 2026 Pentathlon World Cup Final – Budapest (HUN)
- UIPM 2026 Pentathlon World Cup – Catania (ITA)
- UIPM 2025-2028 Obstacle World Championships – Beijing (CHN)

During the second session, the Board reviewed a financial update confirming stable reserves and adherence to budget. The meeting concluded with discussions on brand identity development, including the positioning of UIPM as a parent organisation supporting distinct sport brands.
