- GL starts, the president of the AF and works with UIPM since 2014, member of EC in the last two terms
- SK former Competition Director of HMPA, member of EC in the last term
- JR OLY in Beijing, National Coach for CAN, club manager in Calgary
- MT from the MP and Obstacle Federation of Malta
- PW former Competition Director of UIPM, FISU MP TC Chair

## 6. Shooting homologation brief – Maxime Papillon

- MP presents the current market, which is in good condition and maintained well, more & more homologated products on the market, homologation in collaboration with University of Siegen
- New companies from Brazil and China are interested in the production of equipment
- ***A new pistol testing device is under development by Dr Klaus Hartmann, will be ready at mid-season of 2025***
- SF asks for easier access to the homologated equipment on UIPM website

## 7. Pistol test in practice - Sándor Kármán

- SK presents the pistol tests at the competition sites, once or twice a year, more than 1700 were tested
- Pistol testing device needs to be available for all producers to test their new products in the same way

- GL explains, two wireless system were checked, the AUS one works indoor, but not outdoors, FRA one is too complicated, thus expensive, not for MP
- ***A LED technology for the masks (to light up when a touch is done) is under development will be presented later this year***

- AF reacts on SK's question why EC was not involved in the obstacle discipline preparation – AC, CC, MC and TC + an obstacle expert was involved in the Obstacle Working Group approved by the UIPM EB
- Only two years' experience, still learning process, but standards have been created
- Many aspects to be considered for a not simple Worldwide homologation project
- ***Backbone structure of obstacle homologation is under preparation by the UIPM HQ for a broader project to present the EC***
